# Three Illegal Aliens. Three Dead Women

Congressman **Salud Carbajal** voted against the **Laken Riley Act**, named after the college nursing student who was recently brutally murdered. The Act seeks to force the federal government to prosecute and deport illegal aliens who have committed crimes, and it would allow states to sue the federal government when their residents are harmed by illegal immigration. No Republican voted against the bill, while 37 democrats split from their party to support it.

Carbajal's vote was no surprise. In 2015, Carbajal opposed Kate's Law, which sought to prevent undocumented immigrants from repeatedly entering the country after deportation while imposing additional penalties on those with prior convictions. It was named after **Kate Steinle** who was killed by an illegal alien who admitted shooting her but claimed it was an accident and a jury agreed. Nevertheless, the perpetrator had been previously deported five times and had been convicted of seven felonies before her death.

Weeks after Kate Steinle's death, Santa Maria resident and military veteran **Marilyn Pharis**, was raped, tortured, and brutally murdered by **Victor Martinez**, an illegal alien. Martinez had been arrested six times in 15 months, including weeks before the attack on Pharis. Santa Maria police chief **Ralph Martin** indicated they were forced to cite and release Martinez because of state-mandated sanctuary city policies. Chief Martin added, "I am not remiss to say that from Washington, D.C. to Sacramento, there's a blood trail leading to the bedroom of Marilyn Pharis."

## Three Illegal Aliens. Three Dead Women.

Unfortunately, that is just the tip of the iceberg. U.S. Immigration and Custom Enforcement (ICE) Enforcement and Removal Operations officers arrested 73,822 noncitizens with criminal histories in fiscal year 2023. This group had 290,178 associated charges and convictions with an average of four per individual. These included 33,209 assaults, 4,390 sex and sex assaults, 7,520 weapons offenses, 1,713 charges or convictions for homicide, and 1,655 kidnapping offenses. However, that too is only the tip of the iceberg as ICE admitted their unit uses "inherent discretion" in

# Gov. Newsom So Afraid Trump Will Win, He's Doubling Down On... Climate Change?

*Politico reports climate change policy most important to Newsom – the people, not so much*

Governor Gavin Newsom is preparing an army of bureaucrats to protect California's climate policies against a second Trump administration. You read that right. With California's visible melt-down, the elitist governor is focused on climate change.

In "California is preparing to defend itself — and the nation — against Trump 2.0.," Politico reported:

Newsom administration officials are keenly aware that deep-blue California is a prime target for former President Donald Trump's political diatribes and policy rollbacks — and they fully expect he'll resume his attacks on the Golden State if he wins in November.

This is the governor's concern — "the state's nation-leading climate policies" — even as California has a \$77 billion budget deficit, ranks dead last in the nation on job growth, and has 200,000 homeless zombies taking over cities.

Politico claims:

"California officials are dusting off the playbook that made them a bulwark against former President Donald Trump from 2016-2020."

Politico continues:

Trump campaign officials openly acknowledge that they plan to attack California policies, confirming to POLITICO this week that the state's electric vehicle programs would be a top target.

"We know the playbook," said Newsom at the recent signing of a climate change agreement with Sweden. "We're definitely trying to future-proof California in every way, shape or form."

Trump campaign officials address California's draconian, worst-in-the-nation climate change regulations, costing taxpayers billions, and amount to nothing

more than climate woo-woo conferences and round table discussions — and state funding funneled to connected elitist and also leftist NGOs and non-profits.

"Under President Donald J. Trump's leadership, the United States became the number one producer of oil and natural gas on earth, achieving American energy independence and delivering historically low costs for oil, gas, diesel, and electricity to consumers and businesses," Trump says.

What is Newsom afraid of?

## America Is Now A Debtor Nation

The United States of America is in a financial debt spiral, and it may be too late to recover. The amount of debt being carried by both individuals and at every level of government is staggering.

Santa Barbara County borrows large sums of money regularly that must be repaid by either ratepayers or taxpayers. These loans are typically created by a debt instrument known as a Certificate of Participation, by which the county leverages an asset it owns to qualify for the loan. The largest project – the county's waste-to-energy resource center – cost upwards of \$250 million (with interest), and it is not working.

This week, the supervisors authorized \$174 million in new debt for: refurbishing the south county jail (\$20 million), improvements to Lake Cachuma (\$7.5 million), a new probation dept headquarters (\$55 million,) a fire station (\$5.1 million,) and a regional fire communications center (\$17.6 million), to name a few of the projects on its agenda. Unlike bond measures that require voter approval, the county now owes upwards of \$400 million in loans that the supervisors authorized without a vote of the people.

### Santa Barbara County "In the Red" for \$1.7 billion

In addition to the \$400 million in loans, Santa Barbara County owes some \$800 million in unfunded pension liabilities. Moreover, the county continues to fall behind in maintaining the roads, bridges, and parks that it owns. The total price tag to tackle deferred maintenance is estimated to be \$527 million. Altogether, counting the loans, pension liabilities, and deferred maintenance, county supervisors are in the red to the tune of \$1.7 billion.

The primary source of county revenues to help pay for the above is local property taxes. Yet, the county is sabotaging this revenue stream in multiple ways. One of the dumbest? By buying up properties to house the homeless, such as the old sorority house in IV, which takes those properties off the tax rolls. Or, as Supervisor **Laura Capps** wants to do, allow county property to be used for the construction of affordable housing.

These housing projects too would pay no taxes.

Another thing the county does is deter future development by exacting exorbitant fees on new development. The worst of these costs are called traffic mitigation fees, which are charged to accumulate funds for road improvements and congestion relief.

For instance, if somebody wants to build a 2,000 sq ft 7-Eleven in the unincorporated area near Goleta, the traffic mitigation fee would be \$974,202.

A 3,000 sq ft bank with a drive thru? \$2,428,692.

A 50,000 sq ft shopping center? \$5,240,000.

Note to those politicians who would like to raise taxes to help make ends meet: we the people can't afford it! Consider the fact that the New York Federal Reserve found that total household debt stands at \$17 trillion. Credit card balances alone total well over \$1 trillion.

California state and local government debt is nearly \$2 trillion. This includes \$145 billion in bonds that must be paid off along with local government debt at \$361 billion. Unfunded health benefits to retirees add another \$184 billion, along with nearly \$1 trillion in state government unfunded pension liabilities. Finally, there is the low-ball estimate of some \$60 billion needed to finance an accumulation of unfunded maintenance for roads, highways, and freeways

The U.S. National Debt is heading to \$35 trillion... and beyond. This past year, interest on the debt came to \$659 billion. No economy in the history of the world has survived this level of national debt as measured by the debt/gross domestic production ratio.

What to do? We must drastically reduce waste, fraud and abuse, and the size of the federal government, along with its bad habit of printing money when it runs out of funds. We could start with Senator **Rand Paul's** "Festivus" Report on federal government overspending, which identified some \$900 billion in waste.

Nine hundred billion is "not much," but it is a start!

## The Holy Heresy Reparation Shakedown!

## Biden Administration Oblivious To AB 5's Job-killing Lessons As It Tries To Take AB 5 Nationwide

**SACRAMENTO** – Perhaps I'm old fashioned, but I don't see a role for government in determining working arrangements beyond some basic rules governing safety and non-discrimination. In a free society with a generally healthy economy, employers and employees can hammer out their own deals. As long as force or coercion isn't involved, it's not the Legislature's or federal bureaucracy's concern whether someone, say, takes contract jobs or full-time employment.

I cannot recall a single time that any government rule has improved my life in any noticeable way. It's usually the opposite. After the Legislature passed Assembly Bill 5 – the “landmark” labor law that largely banned companies from using independent contractors – many Californians lost their freelance income, with many adopting costly workarounds that involved myriad legal and accounting costs. Thanks very much for the “protections.”

AB 5 was an unmitigated disaster. That should be obvious to any policymaker in California and at the national level. An old friend of mine had a saying that went, “even the worm learns.” It referred to a scientific experiment that found if you prod the dumbest of creatures (worms) several thousand times they will eventually learn not to squirm in a particular direction. The Biden administration is filled with Californians (Kamala Harris, Xavier Becerra, Julie Su), yet they somehow missed the requisite lesson. They apparently need a lot more prodding.

To recall, the California Supreme Court in the 2018 Dynamex decision imposed a strict ABC test on companies that used contractors. The case involved a delivery service that shifted its workforce from permanent employees to contractors. The court decided that contractors must be A) outside the control of the company; B) do work outside the company's core mission; and C) be working as contractors in general. Unions were giddy. The Legislature codified the decision in AB 5.

California's progressive Democrats, who apparently spend little time talking to normal people, were shocked at the results. Instead of hiring contractors as full-time workers with 9-5 schedules and oodles of benefits, companies downsized their workforces. Un-

ions claimed they were battling “wage theft” – but there is no theft when willing workers take jobs from willing employers at agreed-upon terms.

In the midst of stay-at-home, lawmakers got an earful from struggling Californians who no longer were free to pursue home-based incomes. Volunteer musical and arts gigs had to shutter as a result of these work prohibitions. Lawmakers promised advancements for workers, but instead made their lives miserable. The funniest result: A publication that advocated for the law laid off its California workers.

The Legislature ultimately exempted 100-plus industries from the law. Voters then approved an initiative (still tied up in the courts) that exempted ride-sharing

# Confessions Of A Job-Killing Poverty-Inducing Political Machine

Upward mobility has been described as climbing a ladder of success. Unfortunately, the middle rungs of that ladder have been sawn off (on purpose!), thereby creating perpetual poverty for a significant percentage of our population. To understand the local magnitude of this phenomenon, consider the “confession” by a former county official who stated, “the cost of preserving the high quality of life in Santa Barbara County includes limiting economic opportunities for others.”

Accordingly, county supervisors have gone to extraordinary lengths to hide the impacts of their policies on the “others.” When reporting poverty statistics, the supervisors mask the disparities between the north and south county by designating the Lompoc and the Santa Ynez valleys as “mid-county,” a made-up delineation.

## Keeping the Poor, Poor

There are three primary programs administered by the county to poor people in our region: Medi-Cal (health benefits), CalFresh (formerly known as food stamps), and CalWorks (formerly known as welfare). The stunning statistics having to do with these programs is that upwards of 72% to 90% of all the recipients of these programs live in either the Lompoc valley (Lompoc had zero job growth between 2010 and 2020) or the greater Santa Maria valley (Santa Maria, Orcutt, Guadalupe and Casmalia). Specifically, of the 168,427 people who receive taxpayer-funded healthcare, 72 % of them live in the North County. That is an astounding 52% of the entire north county population.

Why is there so much poverty in the North County? It has to do with our blue-collar job base and the government policies that continue to destroy it. The

## Ditch The Select Committee On Happiness And Public Policy Outcomes, And Get Out Of Our Way

The annual World Happiness Report was released last week, and it shockingly found that the United States failed to rank in the top 20 happiest countries.

Perhaps in response, former Assembly Speaker Anthony Rendon has created a first-in-the-nation group to study the issue, called the Select Committee on Happiness and Public Policy Outcomes. The committee recently had its first hearing.

“Because if we have everybody clothed, everybody housed, everybody has a job and they’re miserable, then we’ve failed at what we’re trying to do,” he said, adding that lawmakers should make happiness a priority for policy makers.

But while Rendon’s concern is appreciated, and the state already involves itself in a great many aspects of our lives, happiness is not the government’s to give. So, what is a government to do when its populace, as Rendon claims, is miserable?

Well, our Founding Fathers gave us the right to *pursue* happiness and, in that regard, the state, as a guardian of our rights, has something it can do:

Get out of the way!

California is one of the highest taxed states in the country, we are at the top or near the top in every major tax category besides property taxes. Even then, with Proposition 13’s protections, we are not a low property tax state, we’re somewhere in the middle.

When it comes to starting a business, California is one of the worst. Recently, the nonpartisan Tax Foundation ranked California 48th in its 2024 State Business Tax Climate Index. California is number three in

Americans for Tax Reform’s “judicial hellhole” list because the state’s “novel theories of liability” are burdening small businesses and bogging down the state’s economy.

Pile all the extra mandates, rules, regulations, permits and fees and you see why many California businesses are choosing to relocate or expand to other states.

It could also explain why a U-Haul from Sacramento to Boise costs \$2,409 but only costs \$467 the other way around.

If the state Legislature was truly concerned about the happiness of its citizens, they would lower taxes and give those struggling to get by in this state the peace of mind of a little more money in their pockets.

If that’s too much to ask amid the current budget uncertainty, it could simply investigate how it spends the money it already has before asking us for more. With examples like the rampant fraud at the Employment Development Department, the boondoggle of the bullet train to nowhere and the billions that have gone to homelessness while the problem only gets worse, the state isn’t without places to look when it comes to finding cost savings.

The Legislature could also end its lawsuit against the Taxpayer Protection and Government Accountability Act (TPA).

TPA would close court-created loopholes in Prop. 13 as well as providing additional taxpayer safeguards like giving Californians the right to vote on all new

# The True State Of The U.S. Economy

What is the true condition of the American economy?

Despite the rosy forecast being portrayed by the White House and its media supporters, there are deeply troubling facts that cannot be ignored.

The National debt stands at an unprecedented and unmanageable \$34 trillion. Upon Biden's inauguration on Jan. 20, 2021, the total federal debt was \$27,751,896,236,414.77. The President claims he addressed that by cutting the deficit by \$1.7 trillion. A 2023 CNN analysis tells a different story. "Biden's boast leaves out important context. It is true that the federal deficit fell by a total of \$1.7 trillion under Biden in the 2021 and 2022 fiscal years, including a record \$1.4 trillion drop in 2022 – but it is highly questionable how much credit Biden deserves for this reduction. Biden did not mention that the primary reason the deficit fell so substantially was that it had skyrocketed to a record high under Trump in 2020 because of bipartisan emergency pandemic relief spending, then fell as expected as the spending expired as planned. Independent analysts say Biden's own actions, including his laws and executive orders, have had the overall effect of adding to current and projected future deficits, not reducing those deficits."

The current White House has actually taken actions that dramatically increase deficit spending and the national debt. A prime example was the mislabeled \$2 trillion stimulus package, which was less about infrastructure than providing a very big bone to environmental extremists within his party.

Biden also alleges that he done well in addressing employment. A House Budget Committee analysis tells a different story. : Nearly 72 percent of all job gains since 2021 were simply jobs that were being recovered from the pandemic, not new job creation. In fact, when looking at today's economy compared to pre-pandemic levels, employment is up only by 3.7 million. On the other hand, prior to the pandemic, job creation under the prior administration was 6.7 million—3 million more jobs than the current President. Further, Wages Are Not Keeping up with Biden's Inflation Crisis. Real wages are down over 5 percent since President Biden entered the Oval Office.



The Independent Women's Forum explains the issue: "Cumulatively, somewhere around 13.5 million jobs have been added since January 2021. However, most of those were recovered jobs in that they returned after pandemic closures and restrictions came to an end. Across industries, people were rehired when their shuttered workplaces were reopened or after remote workers began to return to their offices. According to congressional analysis, that amounted to a whopping over 70% of the jobs in 2021."

In addition to all that, some of the jobs have been government employment. The Wall Street Journal reports that "Public-sector jobs at the federal, state and local level have risen by 327,000 positions so far in 2023, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. That is approaching one-fifth of all new American jobs created in the first eight months of the year. In contrast, public-sector jobs accounted for 5% of employment growth during the equivalent period last year. Government agencies have boosted funding for new hires and have dangled richer perks. This year's growth in public-sector jobs represents the highest share of overall U.S. payroll gains since 2001, when the government hired masses of workers focused on public safety after the 9/11 terrorist attacks"

Lately, the White House has claimed "success" in fighting inflation, The current inflation rate is 3.4%, But that snapshot view masks the true problem. Cumulative inflation under President Biden grew is at 17.1 percent. A family of four is paying \$15,133 per year,

Cesar Conde, the Chair of NBCUniversal News, justified firing Ronna McDaniel by stating that, "no organization, particularly a newsroom, can succeed unless it is cohesive and aligned."

Below is the real story of how NBC News and MSNBC became "cohesive and aligned" on the far Left...

## The King of Hate Media

NBC's takeover by Comcast was lubricated by a corrupt deal with hatermonger Al Sharpton. Faced with stiff political opposition to his plan to take control of NBC, Comcast owner Brian L. Roberts met with Sharpton to pitch him on garnering political support for

the cable company's bid.

Once a pariah for his role in inciting anti-Semitic riots that lynched two innocent people, and the torching of Freddie's Fashion Mart, a Harlem store owned by a Jew whom Sharpton referred to as a "white interloper" in which 7 people were burned to death, all of them "of color," Sharpton was resurrected by Barack Obama as his "civil rights" adviser and accepted into the Democrat fold as the party's kingmaker.

In his new role, Sharpton delivered the political support to ensure that Roberts didn't encounter antitrust issues in his controversial takeover bid to acquire NBC. In return, Roberts gave Sharpton his own MSNBC show, 'PoliticsNation with Al Sharpton', while also making Sharpton's existing employers at black-owned Radio One – and himself – extremely rich.

Without the support of Sharpton and his racist admirers, Comcast would not have been able to gain control of NBC and so it's hardly surprising that it streams the worst lies and hate by the worst bigots as a payback for the series of dirty deals that made Roberts so rich and powerful.

During Sharpton's lobbying for the Comcast deal, MSNBC denied that there was an offer to give the notorious racial arsonist his own show, only to debut it a few months later. Comcast not only gave Sharpton a show, but included the head of his racist National Action Network in its "diversity council." Sharpton in turn gave MSNBC boss Phil Griffin an award after previously handing it to Jeff Zucker, who ran NBC at the time, before going off to run CNN.

Alongside Joy Reid and Sharpton, MSNBC regularly features the unhinged Elie Mystal, who said that the United States "Constitution is trash" and bragged, "you come out as a Republican, I'm prejudiced against you", Tiffany Cross, who argued that the media focusing on the economic concerns of midwesterners was pandering to "racist white people", Melissa Harris-Perry, who claimed that the term "hard work" is racist, and a seemingly bottomless list of bigots.

MSNBC doesn't just employ vile racists like Reid and Sharpton who smear our country and promote hate, but also foreign enemy propagandists like Ayman Mo-

hyeldin, formerly of Qatar's *Al Jazeera*, who defended the Islamic terrorist state during the World Cup by attacking America.

Mohyeldin is one of a number of former employees of the Qatari propaganda network who have been given a platform to attack America, Europe and Israel by MSNBC. While Mohyeldin has 'Ayman', his own weekend show, Mehdi Hasan, also formerly of *Al Jazeera*, hosts 'The Mehdi Hasan Show'. Al Velshi, a veteran of *Al Jazeera America*, which faced lawsuits accusing its executives of antisemitism and discriminating against women, hosts 'Velshi'.

MSNBC's decision to turn itself into *Al Jazeera* by stocking it with the Jihadist network's leftovers has led to constant incitement and antisemitic propaganda at its 24/7 hate network.

Even in the midst of China's takeover of Hong Kong and the Ukraine war, Velshi ranted that Israel was the "leading occupying force in the world." Velshi claimed that "Israel captured East Jerusalem from Jordan during the Six-Day War in 1967" while neglecting to mention that it was Jordan that as part of the unprovoked Arab Muslim attack on the infant state had captured half the city in 1948 launching the Arabs' 75-year campaign "to push the Jews into the sea." In other words Jerusalem was liberated by Israel from *Jordanian* occupation in 1967.

Velshi has smeared Israel as an "apartheid state" despite working as a propagandist for Qatar where 88% of the population consists of migrant workers with no rights, thousands of whom die laboring on the skyscrapers of the Islamist apartheid state. Israel by contrast is the only state in the Middle East that is actually not an apartheid state. Velshi's comments are just the crudest form of Jew hating propaganda spawned by the apartheid regimes in Gaza and the West Bank.

On his hate-filled show, Mehdi Hasan invited Rep. Ro Khanna, a Bernie Sanders ally, to make the bizarre claim that Israel was "burning down Palestinian villages". Hasan, who has falsely referred to Israel as having its capital in Tel Aviv, regularly hosts anti-Israel bigots like Peter Beinart. Rep. Ilhan Omar and Rep.

Rashida Tlaib. Tlaib used her MSNBC platform to lie that Israel is "an apartheid government that is targeting a whole people based on their ethnicity and some even based on their faith." That would be news to the Arab Israelis who have more rights as citizens of Israel than they would in any Arab Muslim state.

But it's not just the cable network MSNBC that Roberts polluted. After the recent Colorado Springs shooting at a gay club, NBC senior reporter Brandy Zadrozny falsely blamed the attack on critics of the sexualization of children.

"If there is a pipeline it starts from some smaller accounts online like Libs of TikTok, it moves to the right-wing blogosphere, and then it ends up on Tucker Carlson or it ends up out of a right-wing politician's mouth," she argued.

state and local taxes.

It is especially needed now because the urge for new taxes has never been greater as the state goes from a \$100 billion surplus to a more than \$60 billion deficit, with multiple years of projected shortfalls on the horizon.

California voters should have the right to vote on future taxes to ensure their voice is heard on when and how new revenue is raised and spent.

The governor, legislative leadership and public employee unions oppose the voters having this right, and instead want the power to raise unlimited taxes for unlimited spending, without any say from the voters who are paying those taxes – and they are suing to keep it off the ballot.

People are the happiest when they feel in control of their lives. The Legislature's Select Committee on Happiness and Public Policy Outcomes would be wise to find more ways to stay out of our business and remember that government is responsible to us, not the other way around.

or \$1,261 per month, more to purchase the same goods and services compared to the day President Biden took office. This a problem substantially created by his Administration, a result of his attack on affordable energy. Imagine visiting your doctor for a fever, which jumped from 98.6 to 102. He tells you not to worry even though you are now at 105, but its ok because it's going up more slowly!

Just as the national debt and government spending have exploded, so too have the problems faced by families. The Heritage Foundation summarized the impact in four statistics: Real disposal income per capita has reduced 7.5%, home ownership affordability is down 36.3%, credit card debt is up 38.7%, and monthly savings are down 79.3%.

A CNET report from the Federal Reserve on Household Debt and Credit noted that "In August, the Federal Reserve Bank of New York released its Household Debt and Credit Report for the second quarter of 2023 with one particularly eye-popping statistic: Americans had surpassed a combined total of over \$1 trillion in credit card debt. Three months later, the balance had already gone up an additional \$48 billion."

A recent Fortune article noted that "A new report by Bankrate found that 35% of U.S. adults carry credit card debt from month to month, up from 29% last year and 46% of credit cardholders carry debt from month to month on at least one card, up from 39% last year."

largest industry in the north county is agriculture. Traditionally, a significant number of people working in this sector, most of whom are immigrants, would eventually transition to any number of better paying jobs, including manufacturing and industry, oil, trucking, and construction, the very job sectors that have been decimated by government policies.

Our county lost over 20,000 manufacturing and industrial jobs since the 1980s, many due to environmental overkill. The oil industry, whose workforce, in some instances, was comprised of 76% Hispanic workers has been shut down primarily due to climate change machinations. One of the largest trucking companies in the north county just closed its business. Trucking has been destroyed by the California diesel engine rule which required the purchase and use of brand-new diesel trucks (along with new heavy equipment in the construction and farming sectors) which was extremely cost-prohibitive. And now, this sector is being told they must replace their big rigs *again* by going all-electric, which is even more prohibitive considering costs and recharging logistics.

### Project Labor Agreements Follies

The latest example of this economically disparate disconnect impacts the construction industry. On the same day county supervisors reviewed the aforementioned poverty statistics having to do with various welfare programs, they also approved plans to construct a new \$55 million probation admin building in downtown Santa Barbara. However, supervisors limited the ability of non-union construction workers to work on this project by way of a "project labor agreement" with local unions. This, even though most construction workers, 85% to be exact, including most minority construction workers, don't belong to a union. That is, while more than 50% of the construction workforce in California is Hispanic, only 36% of Hispanics belong to a union, and just 7.7% of construction union members are black.

An economist once informed county supervisors that they did not need to worry about job creation because there are virtually no jobs in the Carmel-Monterey area, and they are getting along just fine. He stated that our similarly wealthy neighborhoods generate property taxes and tourism, which generate sales taxes and

bed taxes, and which can generate enough tax revenue to keep government afloat.

In essence, what serves to float the boat of wealthy communities serves to sink the North County economy.

drivers. Granted, lawmakers have legislative cars at their disposal, but those of us who take Uber and Lyft – and routinely talk with our drivers – realize most of them do not want to work full time for those companies. They like flexible schedules and fill-in work as they pursue college or other careers.

Apparently, the Biden administration doesn't pay attention to California news events. Through it all, the president has doggedly pursued implementing some variety of AB 5 through legislation and the federal Department of Labor. It recently implemented a new rule that echoes ABC test standards. The new rule doesn't have the authority of something passed by Congress or legislatures, but it makes it tougher to classify workers as contractors and could disrupt many industries. It's clearly an attempt to promote AB 5's rules.

In a strikingly biased article, the Los Angeles Times' Noah Bierman chides some conservative publications for claiming that the president is taking California's approach nationwide, when it merely restores the old Obama administration approach to these matters. Yet Bierman admits that Biden's "promise to replicate California's law at the national level has fallen victim to congressional gridlock and industry clout."

In other words, the president promised to replicate AB 5 nationally but has failed. I can only surmise that the Los Angeles Times doesn't pay much attention to California news, either. As noted above, AB 5 isn't the victim of Congress or industry – but of massive, an-

gry blowback from California freelancers – many of them Democrats – in multiple professions who didn't appreciate losing their jobs. The story focused on San Francisco's settlement with a company that connects workers with hospitality industry jobs, so AB 5 is still wreaking havoc.

The most aggravating part of the Times article cites a study from the pro-union Economic Policy Institute, which finds "blue-collar workers classified as contractors are losing out on as much as \$16,700 a year compared with what they would have made as regular employees." Perhaps it should show how much money these workers are losing when companies axe their jobs because of the AB 5-style mandates. When it comes to economics, union think tanks, reporters and the Biden administration are as clever as those proverbial worms.

determining who to arrest and remove. Why give convicted criminals additional opportunities to commit more crimes against American citizens under the guise of "inherent discretion"?

Moreover, from Feb. 5 to Feb. 16, 2024, ICE announced they arrested 36 noncitizens with prior sex offense convictions in Los Angeles and another 41 in San Francisco. Gov. Newsom's actions demonstrate that he doesn't care about the people or workers of California, but excitedly rolled out the red carpet for China's Xi Jinping and cleaned up San Francisco, removing the homeless vagrants, their public toilets and street camps. **Oakland-Berkeley:** 81,300 short – 11,400 past four years vs. 92,800 for 2015-19. That's off 88%.

**Inland Empire:** 70,500 short – 128,400 past four years vs. 198,900 for 2015-19. That's off 35%.

**San Jose-Santa Clara:** 63,600 short – 36,500 past four years vs. 100,100 for 2015-19. That's off 64%.

**San Diego County:** 48,300 short – 69,900

We have since learned that the shooter, who comes from a deeply dysfunctional household, identifies as “non-binary.” A normal TV network in normal times would fire a reporter for spewing such a hateful lie. But these are not normal times, and Brian Roberts’ network is a big reason why.

These lies, smears and slurs, like many others, come down to one company, Comcast, and one man, Brian L. Roberts. Comcast is a family business and Brian was born into it. “I think we have known that Brian would take over the company since he was about eight years old,” its co-founder admitted. At 30, he did just that and took the company from cable to content.

Unlike his father, Brian was not satisfied just providing cable access and was obsessed with taking control of programming. After a failed bid to take over Disney, he bought NBC.

MSNBC had begun purging its conservative personalities in a leftist makeover even before the Comcast takeover, but the process accelerated rapidly as talks began. And Comcast bought support for the takeover by handing out money to racists and their hate groups.

That was how Al Sharpton ended up with an MSNBC show.

During the Black Lives Matter race riots, Roberts promised that Comcast would donate \$100 million in response to “the far too familiar and frequent acts of violence against the black community, and to acknowledge the structural racism that fuels these

injustices” to a consortium of groups including Sharpton’s National Action Network. At the same time, Roberts’ protégé was busy pouring oil on the flames in a eulogy for George Floyd by condemning America for having its “knee on the neck” of black people for over 400 years. In point of fact, black slavery in America lasted 20 years in the north and 76 years in the south. Moreover, black slaves in America had been enslaved by black Africans and sold at slave auctions in Ghana and Benin. Black slaves were liberated at the cost of 360,000 mainly white lives in America’s bloodiest war. When Sharpton poured his racist poison onto America’s television screens 80% of blacks were living above the poverty line and “systemic racism” had been outlawed for over 60 years.

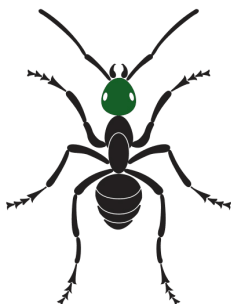

did because it adopted the right politics and paid off the right people.

In 2020, Roberts' wife provided \$152,800 to fund the Biden campaign. But that was small change compared to the millions raised by Comcast's chief lobbyist for Obama whom Biden has appointed as the ambassador to Canada. Roberts took to golfing with Obama and hosting him on Martha's Vineyard. And even that money was dwarfed by the subsidies from the tax-free Comcast Foundation.

The Comcast Foundation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit that the powerful company has used to build its political connections while dodging taxes. As was noted during the NBC takeover, the Comcast Foundation, dominated by its top lobbyist, handed out "more than \$3 billion since 2001" mostly to minority groups and "many of the groups to whom the Comcast Foundation has donated now support the proposed merger". A number of the Comcast Foundation's donations conveniently also went to organizations which had ties to Democrat politicians.

Comcast wasn't just bribing its way to power, taxpayers were subsidizing the bribes.

This is another example of what *Internal Radical Service*, a report by David Horowitz and John Perazzo, delved into. Published by the David Horowitz Free-

dom Center, the report documented the abuse of the tax code by leftist foundations and nonprofits which are being used to finance the left's agendas while the IRS watchdogs turn a blind eye to the violations.

Comcast is a corrupt company that pushes hate for profit. And Brian L. Roberts, who got the job because of his daddy, has used it to tear apart this country and reward the worst and most divisive bigots.

Despite the Jewish origins of the Roberts family, Brian Roberts has overseen a company that spreads the worst lies emanating from the terrorist propaganda machines of Hamas and the PLO. The anti-Semitic chorus at MSNBC, posing as journalists, promotes the worst smears against Israel and Jews in America.

The story of Comcast, like the tragic tale of so many other major and increasingly international companies, is that of powerful corporations turning on their own roots, on the country and the people that made them possible. Torn away from their values and roots, they become a virus that destroys everything around them. past four years vs. 118,200 for 2015-19. That's off 41%.

**Sacramento:** 36,900 short – 67,600 past four years vs. 104,500 for 2015-19. That's off 35%.”

Gov. Newsom is lying to the people, and cooking the books to make it look like his policies are working. And that is because Newsom puts government over what's best for the people. And he puts himself over everything else.

Newsom was even warned about how disastrous the \$20 fast food minimum wage would be by his billionaire Panera Bread owner friend. But he signed the bill into law anyway, and ahead of the April 1st start date, fast food restaurants are already laying off employees. And now he's chosen his favorites in the fast food industry by exempting high-cost locations: airports, hotels, event centers, casinos, while ignoring the small franchise owners who will be forced to pay the \$20 minimum wage.

It's a clear attack on the middle class, not only harming these small business owners, but preventing new owners from entering the franchise market.

These are issues that Gov. Newsom could address and reverse. But instead he blathers about climate change.

And Politico reports this as a good thing: “You can count on California to be a stable partner and a strong partner on climate change, for all the prevailing winds that shift in Washington, D.C.,” Newsom said on an October trip to China where he signed five climate agreements with local governments and national agencies.”

They can't get enough of Gavin, even as he openly bilks Californians with “agreements to meet about adaptation strategies to plans to exchange monitoring methods for emissions — with little in the way of details, specific goals or targets. (They're also non-binding, like the Paris Agreement and other international climate pacts.)”

Newsom agreed with China “to refine cap-and-trade markets, decarbonize industry, promote biodiversity and transition to zero-emission vehicles.”

We must ask ourselves why Gov. Newsom cut deals with the Communist Chinese.

But he's right to be afraid of another Trump administration.
